MOAAMS Charity

PAIP – DJ brought a copy of the PAIP that the programs from Air Methods and Med Flight of Ohio use for their shared air craft. We will review and begin discussing our own state wide PAIP.

Possible Educational Offerings from MOAAMS – There was discussion about offering “Just Culture” and possibly a review course for certification. Jill Johnson was mentioned as a possible instructor for the review course.

Dick Whipple discussed temperature monitoring in air crafts and asked if anyone had a particular product they were using. Dick discussed a fairly inexpensive product that LFE was using and that it was easy to download the temperatures for permanent records. Dick will share product information with the group.
